The tower's façade insulated glass units use **Guardian SunGuard SuperNeutral 68** low-E on the #3 surface on the clear inboard lite with a gray outboard. This glass make up provides abun-

dant natural light and significant energy savings. The high-performance glazing brings natural light deep into the six-story structure while providing outstanding solar energy control, which helps reduce electric lighting and HVAC loads.
